

SCHOOL OUTCOMES IN NATIONAL ASSESSMENTS 2016-17

End of EYFS outcomes (7 children)

86% of children attained a good level of development compared with 71% nationally in 2017.

The three year trend of attainment in EYFS is consistently above national.

Phonics check

100% of the 9 Y1 children reached the expected standard in the Y1 phonics check compared to 81% nationally in 2017. The three year trend of attainment in the Y1 phonics check shows an upward trend.

By the end of KS1, 82% of the 11 children in the Year 2 cohort have met the expected standard compared to 91% nationally in 2016.
