You can also help your child learn their spellings offline! Here are a few ideas!

- Use over-pronunciation.
- Try making some silly sentences: challenge your child to write a silly sentence, including as many of the words on their spelling list as possible.
- Ask children to write down the words that they need to remember how to spell. The act of writing the words by hand helps to anchor the spelling in children's memories and encourages them to think about the letters that represent the sounds in the word.
- Playing games such as hangman can help children to learn about spelling in an enjoyable way.
